Sheep Yards



Our sheep yards and products are custom manufactured and made to withstand the daily wear and tear of farm life.

Whether you are a farmer or small property owner, we'll take the time to

listen and find out exactly what your need so that we can *custom* design our products to suit you and budget. We make both portable and fixed yards and *Farmweld* sheep gates, flags and panels are all constructed from quality hot dipped galvanised pipe with quality and safety in mind for both you and your animals.

THE MANUFACTURING PROCESS...

We accurately measure and then notch all the joints in the panel. This is done to provide a cleaner looking and stronger joint which will distribute loads more widely and evenly within the structure and also provide a smoother joint with less chance of animals catching on protrusions.

Once the panels have been MIG welded all of the joints are wire brushed to remove weld residue and spatter and then painted with 'cold galv' to prevent corrosion.

Panels are available in varying lengths up to 3.4 metres. Any panels 2m or longer have a 25x5mm galvanised strap welded down the centreline to help support the rails. The fittings and caps used are all quality hot dipped galvanised items from reputable suppliers.

WHY ARE FARMWELD PANELS SAFER?

Panels with mesh inserts are securely welded, not just tacked, so impact from livestock will not result in the mesh unzipping from the frame. It is also inserted 'inside' the frame so there are no sharp edges to cut you or your stock.

If you have animals that have a tendency to jump then we recommend that you order panels with squared corners. This design feature minimizes the risk of animals trapping their legs between panels, resulting in injury or death to your stock.

SHEEPYARDS

Fixed sheepyard panels:

Standard panels stand 975mm high and have a 25 n/b top rail with either five evenly spaced 20mm n/b rails or six 20



n/b rails with the bottom four being closer together to help contain smaller animals and the top two slightly further apart. Blind panels, mesh panels, gates, ramps and drafting races are also available. The 32mm n/b uprights are set 400mm into the ground and depending on your needs there is a choice of either light, medium or heavy wall thicknesses .

Portable sheep panels:

The panels stand 975 mm high. The rail spacing and available lengths are the same as for the fixed panels and there is a range of race bows, blind and gate panels available.

Uneven ground and heavy panels: Longer and heavier panels are easier to moved if dragged. The curved foot on our panels rests more solidly on loose and uneven ground and panels can easily be moved by simply grabbing the end of the panel and dragging.



Joining Panels: We are happy to help you work out which method would suit your needs best. Choose from long or short drop pins, chain and catch or the sliding drop pin.
